

MEDICAL CERTIFICATE SUMMARY OF MINIMUM PERIODIC REQUIREMENTS

The full requirements are detailed in Part-MED
 Note: Any tests may be required at any time if clinically indicated. Examinations and/or assessments for the revalidation of a medical certificate may be undertaken up to 45 days prior to the expiry date of the medical certificate.

- ° A class 2 medical certificate is acceptable for LAPL privileges and validities
