Dear Bebiano Fidelis,

On July 11, 2022, pursuant to 14 C.F.R. § 67.413(a), we requested that you provide additional medical information to determine your qualifications to hold the unrestricted airman medical certificate issued to you by Dr. PATRICK CORREA on December 10, 2021. To date, you have not provided the following information:

- Three blood pressure checks over a 7 day period.

If the readings are consistently elevated, or if the medication is prescribed, you must provide an evaluation to include the following:

- A current statement from your treating physician documenting hypertension is stable on current regimen and no changes are recommended. This statement should include a current blood pressure reading and medications used, the dosage and side effects if any.

As a result of the failure to provide all requested medical information, we are unable to determine your current qualifications to hold an airman medical certificate under the medical standards in 14 C.F.R. subparts B, C, and D. We are sending your file to FAA legal counsel for consideration of legal enforcement action. **Please do NOT return your medical certificate(s) to the FAA unless directed to do so by FAA Legal Counsel.**

We sincerely regret the necessity for this action, however, it is taken in the interest of aviation safety.

PILOT'S BILL OF RIGHTS WRITTEN NOTIFICATION

This letter concerns the Administrator's investigation of your qualifications to continue to hold your current airman medical certificate and advises you of the nature of this investigation. In addition, the Pilot's Bill of Rights, Public Law 112-153, requires that we inform you that :

- Any response to an inquiry by a representative of the Administrator by you in connection with this investigation of your qualifications for an airman medical certificate may be used as evidence against you.
- A copy of the releasable portions of your airman medical file is available to you upon submitting "FAA Form 8065-2 Request For Airman medical Records" to the following address:
