MED.A.020/ATCO.MED.A.020 - Decrease in medical fitness *

- a) Licence holders shall not exercise the privileges of their licence and related ratings or certificates, and student pilots shall not fly solo, at any time when they:
- (1) are aware of any decrease in their medical fitness which might render them unable to safely exercise those privileges;
 - (2) take or use any prescribed or non-prescribed medication which is likely to interfere with the safe exercise of the privileges of the applicable licence;
 - (3) receive any medical, surgical or other treatment that is likely to interfere with the safe exercise of the privileges of the applicable licence.
- b) In addition, holders of a medical certificate shall, without undue delay and before exercising the privileges of their licence, seek aero-medical advice from the AeMC, AME, as applicable, when they:
- (1) have undergone a surgical operation or invasive procedure;
 - (2) have commenced the regular use of any medication;
 - (3) have suffered any significant personal injury involving incapacity to function as a member of the flight crew;
 - (4) have been suffering from any significant illness involving incapacity to function as a member of the flight crew;
 - (5) are pregnant;
 - (6) have been admitted to hospital or medical clinic;
 - (7) first require correcting lenses.

MED.A.020/ATCO.MED.A.020 - Eingeschränkte flugmedizinische Tauglichkeit *

- a) Lizenzinhaber dürfen die mit ihrer Lizenz und mit zugehörigen Berechtigungen oder Zeugnissen verbundenen Rechte nicht ausüben und Flugschüler dürfen nicht allein fliegen, wenn sie:
- (1) sich der Einschränkung ihrer flugmedizinischen Tauglichkeit bewusst sind, die es ihnen unmöglich machen könnte, ihre Rechte sicher auszuüben;
 - (2) ein verschreibungspflichtiges oder nicht verschreibungspflichtiges Arzneimittel einnehmen oder anwenden, das sie in der sicheren Ausbildung der mit der verwendeten Lizenz verbundenen Rechte wahrscheinlich gefährdet;
 - (3) sich einer medizinischen Behandlung, einem chirurgischen Eingriff oder einer anderen Behandlung unterziehen, die die sichere Ausübung der mit der verwendeten Lizenz verbundenen Rechte wahrscheinlich gefährdet.
- b) Weiterhin müssen sich Inhaber eines Tauglichkeitszeugnisses ohne unangemessene Verzögerung und vor Ausübung der mit ihrer Lizenz verbundenen Rechte von den flugmedizinischen Beratungszentren, flugmedizinischen Sachverständigen flugmedizinisch beraten lassen, wenn sie:
- (1) sich einem chirurgischen Eingriff oder einem invasiven Verfahren unterzogen haben;
 - (2) mit der regelmäßigen Einnahme oder Anwendung von Arzneimitteln begonnen haben;
 - (3) sich eine erhebliche Verletzung zugezogen haben, die eine Tätigkeit als Flugbesatzungsmitglied nicht zulässt;
 - (4) unter einer erheblichen Erkrankung leiden, die eine Tätigkeit als Flugbesatzungsmitglied nicht zulässt;
 - (5) schwanger sind;
 - (6) in ein Krankenhaus oder eine Klinik eingewiesen worden sind;
 - (7) erstmals eine korrigierende Sehhilfe benötigen.

MED.A.020/ATCO.MED.A.020 - Diminution de l'aptitude médicale *

- a) Les titulaires de licence n'exercent à aucun moment les privilèges de leur licence et des qualifications ou certificats qui y sont liés et les élèves-pilotes ne volent jamais en solo s'ils:
- (1) ont connaissance d'une quelconque diminution de leur aptitude médicale susceptible de les rendre incapables d'exercer ces privilèges en toute sécurité;
 - (2) prennent ou utilisent des médicaments prescrits ou non prescrits qui sont susceptibles d'influer sur l'exercice en toute sécurité des privilèges de la licence en question;
 - (3) reçoivent tout traitement médical, chirurgical ou autre susceptible d'influer sur l'exercice en toute sécurité des privilèges de la licence en question.
- b) En outre, les titulaires d'un certificat médical sont tenus d'obtenir auprès de l'AeMC, de l'AME, sans délai et avant d'exercer les privilèges de leur licence, un avis aéromédical lorsqu'ils/elles:
- (1) ont subi une opération chirurgicale ou une procédure invasive;
 - (2) ont entamé la prise régulière d'un médicament;
 - (3) ont souffert de toute blessure grave impliquant une incapacité de travailler comme membre d'équipage;
 - (4) ont souffert d'une maladie grave impliquant une incapacité de travailler comme membre d'équipage;
 - (5) sont enceintes;
 - (6) ont été admis dans un hôpital ou une clinique médicale;
 - (7) ont besoin de verres correcteurs pour la première fois.

MED.A.020/ATCO.MED.A.020 - Diminuzione dell'idoneità medica *

- a) I titolari di licenza non possono esercitare in alcun momento i privilegi della stessa e delle relative abilitazioni o certificazioni, né gli allievi piloti possono pilotare un velivolo da soli, qualora:
- (1) siano consapevoli di una diminuzione della loro idoneità medica che li potrebbe rendere incapaci di esercitare in sicurezza tali privilegi;
 - (2) assumano o utilizzino un farmaco, prescritto o non prescritto, che potrebbe interferire con l'esercizio sicuro dei privilegi della pertinente licenza;
 - (3) ricevano un trattamento medico, chirurgico o di altro tipo che potrebbe interferire con l'esercizio sicuro dei privilegi della pertinente licenza.
- b) I titolari di un certificato medico devono inoltre richiederlo, senza indugio e prima di esercitare i privilegi della loro licenza, la consulenza aeromedica di un AeMC, un AME, qualora:
- (1) abbiano subito un intervento chirurgico o una procedura invasiva;
 - (2) abbiano cominciato ad assumere regolarmente un farmaco;
 - (3) abbiano subito una lesione personale significativa che comporti l'incapacità di operare come membro dell'equipaggio di condotta;
 - (4) abbiano sofferto di una patologia significativa che comporti l'incapacità di operare come membro dell'equipaggio di condotta;
 - (5) siano in stato di gravidanza;
 - (6) siano stati ricoverati in ospedale o in una clinica medica;
 - (7) debbano cominciare a usare lenti correttive.
