MED.A.020 Decrease in medical fitness

License holders shall not exercise the privileges of their licence and related ratings or certificates at any time when they:

- (1) are aware of any decrease in their medical fitness that might render them unable to safely exercise those privileges
- (2) take or use any prescription or non-prescribed medication that is likely to interfere with the safe exercise of the privileges of the applicable licence
- (3) receive any medical, surgical or other treatment that is likely to interfere with flight safety
- (4) are pregnant
- (5) are pregnant
- (6) have been admitted to hospital or medical clinic, or
- (7) test require corrective lenses

In addition, licence holders shall, without prejudice to the above, only work into medical aspects when they have undergone a surgical course of any medication.

They have suffered any significant personal injury involving incapacity to function as a member of the flight crew.

They have been suffering from any significant illness involving incapacity to function as a member of the flight crew.
